### Present

<b>I</b>	outplay
<b>you</b>	outplay
<b>he/she/it</b>	outplays
<b>we</b>	outplay
<b>you</b>	outplay
<b>they</b>	outplay

### Simple past

<b>I</b>	outplayed
<b>you</b>	outplayed
<b>he/she/it</b>	outplayed
<b>we</b>	outplayed
<b>you</b>	outplayed
<b>they</b>	outplayed

### Present perfect

<b>I</b>	have outplayed
<b>you</b>	have outplayed
<b>he/she/it</b>	has outplayed
<b>we</b>	have outplayed
<b>you</b>	have outplayed
<b>they</b>	have outplayed

### Past perfect

<b>I</b>	had outplayed
<b>you</b>	had outplayed
<b>he/she/it</b>	had outplayed
<b>we</b>	had outplayed

### Future

<b>I</b>	will outplay
<b>you</b>	will outplay

## Conditional

### Present continuous

<b>I</b>	am outplaying
<b>you</b>	are outplaying
<b>he/she/it</b>	is outplaying
<b>we</b>	are outplaying
<b>you</b>	are outplaying
<b>they</b>	are outplaying

### Past continuous

<b>I</b>	was outplaying
<b>you</b>	were outplaying
<b>he/she/it</b>	was outplaying
<b>we</b>	were outplaying
<b>you</b>	were outplaying
<b>they</b>	were outplaying

### Present perfect continuous

<b>I</b>	have been outplaying
<b>you</b>	have been outplaying
<b>he/she/it</b>	has been outplaying
<b>we</b>	have been outplaying
<b>you</b>	have been outplaying
<b>they</b>	have been outplaying

### Past perfect continuous

<b>I</b>	had been outplaying
<b>you</b>	had been outplaying
<b>he/she/it</b>	had been outplaying
<b>we</b>	had been outplaying
<b>you</b>	had been outplaying

### Future continuous

<b>I</b>	will be outplaying
<b>you</b>	will be outplaying

<b>you</b>	had outplayed

<b>we</b>	Let's outplay
<b>you</b>	outplay

### Conditional present progressive

<b>I</b>	would be outplaying
<b>you</b>	would be outplaying
<b>he/she/it</b>	would be outplaying
<b>we</b>	would be outplaying
<b>you</b>	would be outplaying
<b>they</b>	would be outplaying

### Conditional perfect progressive

<b>I</b>	would have been outplaying
<b>you</b>	would have been outplaying
<b>he/she/it</b>	would have been outplaying

### Past subjunctive
